

Changed traffic conditions in Broken Hill from Tuesday 16 July

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work on the Barrier Highway in Broken Hill.

What work are we doing?

We will be carrying out repair works to the concrete pavement at three locations in Broken Hill. The work will involve removing the damaged concrete pavement and replacing with a new concrete base to create a smoother and safer surface for all road users.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take commence on **Tuesday 16 July** and is expected to be completed by **Wednesday 24 July**, weather permitting.

We will be working from **7am to 4pm**. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working at three locations in Broken Hill:

- Williams Street (Barrier Highway) near Bromide Street from Tuesday 16 July
- Williams Street (Barrier Highway) near Brookfield Avenue from Wednesday 17 July
- Iodide Street (Barrier Highway) near Mica Street from Thursday 18 July.

The bus stop on Williams Street near Brookfield Avenue will be temporarily moved around the corner on Galena Street for the duration of the works.

Traffic changes

Changed traffic conditions include:

- Reduced speed limit to 40km/h
- Single lane closures
- Intermittent stopping

We understand that this work will generate some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles

Managing our impacts

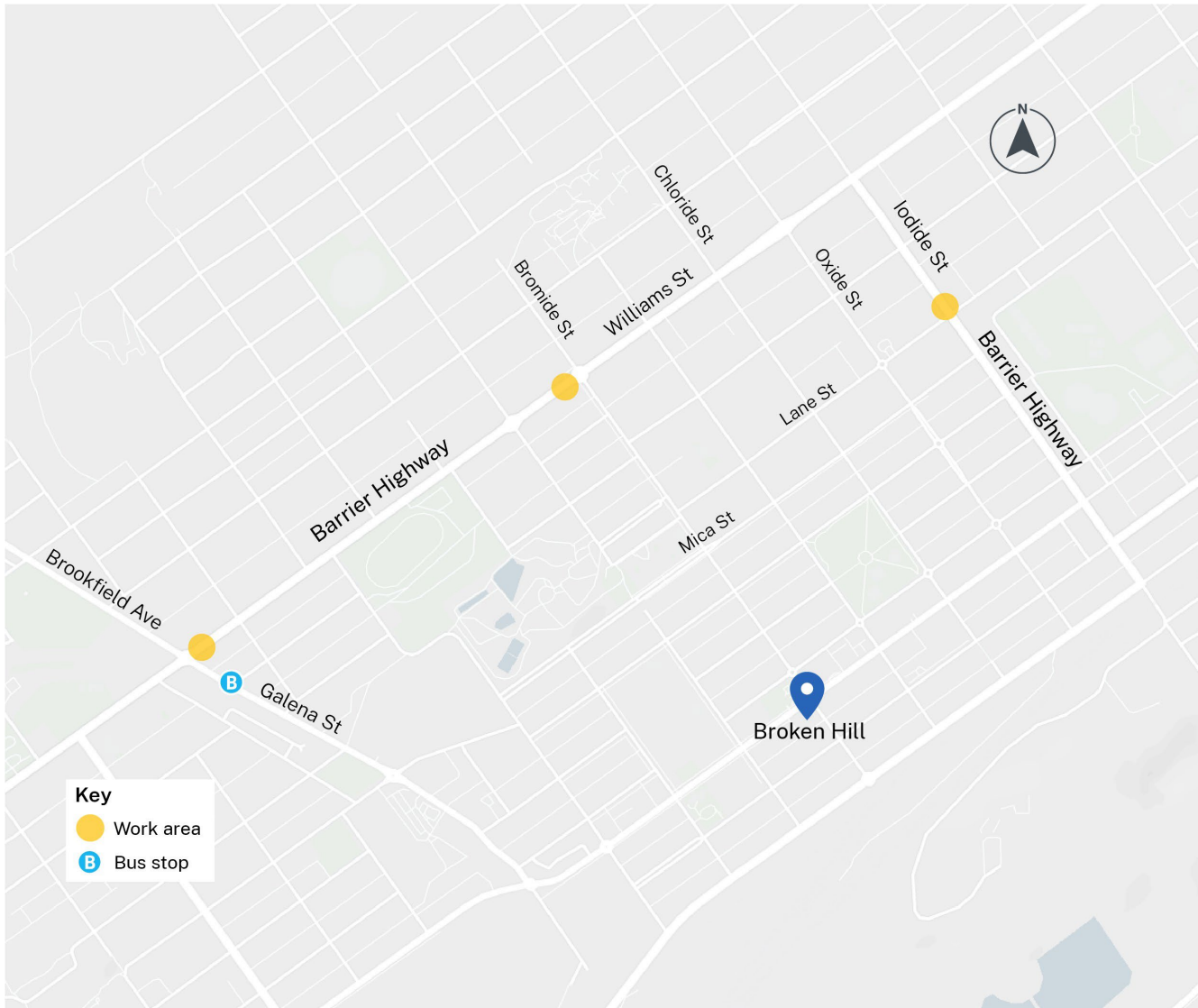
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and environment.
